



Covid-19 Policies and Procedures

- No adult except MSLT staff will be allowed in the school at this time – an exception can be made under certain circumstances
 - Birthday Celebrations
 - We'll try and do them outside when possible
 - Parents are to wear masks
 - Repairs/Building upkeep
 - Licensing and Health Department
 - Special Presentations
- We will have carline from the south and north playground gates or the front entrance. The teachers will be doing all the signing in and out.
- Teachers will escort students in. If a teacher is not at the gate, ring the doorbell or call the school line 303-799-8540.
 - The parent/guardian will get the child out or into the car.
 - We will take their temperature and they will get hand sanitizer prior to playing on the playground. We will sign them in on ELV.
 - We have five No Contact Infrared Forehead Thermometers
 - All doors will remain locked except for carline and the playground/side doors locked unless we are outside playing
- Teachers can wear masks, but it is not required at this time. All MSLT teachers have been fully vaccinated.
- Children can wear masks if the parent prefers IF the child is at least 3 years old and can take it on and off independently. Unless it becomes cumbersome or too distracting.
- Hand washing: lathering for at least 20 seconds for everyone (entering, before eating, after eating, after toileting, after returning from recess)



- We will be utilizing our outdoor environments during the work periods periodically throughout the year.
- Lunches will be served by the teachers – No longer family style
- No students or teachers may attend if they are showing any signs of illness
 - If we become aware that a parent had medicated their child with fever reducing medicine before school, they will be disenrolled until the end of the school year. Teachers would be suspended.
 - If we believe a child is sick – fever or not – the parent/authorized person must pick up within 30 minutes.
- No student or teacher may enter if the family has had direct contact with someone who has contracted Covid-19 until they have quarantined for at least 14 days from last exposure.
- If there is a positive test for Covid-19 from any of our students, staff or those living with such, we will inform the parents and close that cohort the following day for deep cleaning and disinfecting. We will contact the health department for instruction on contact tracing and quarantining.
- If a teacher, child, or parent travel AND HAVE NOT BEEN VACCINATED, please let us know and plan on a two-week self- quarantine following your return. If the adults have been vaccinated, quarantining is not required. You can scan your vaccination card so we can keep it on file.
- No in person tours will be conducted at this time.
- Families and teachers may not return to school if they have not followed the state mandated quarantine and complied with masks in public and social distancing. Currently there is no mask mandates, but it is recommended for non-vaccinated individuals.
